PROCEDURE

For each step, the student will check off a "task completed" box.

Run the engine for 2-3 minutes. Turn the wheel lock to lock several times to bring the fluid to proper operating temperature.	_____
Turn the engine off, raise the hood, and locate the power steering pump and reservoir.	_____
Remove the top of the reservoir. Check the power steering fluid level.	_____
Check the power steering fluid for contamination, such as water or foreign material.	_____
If the fluid level is low, refer to the service manual for the power steering fluid suggested for your specific vehicle. Fill the reservoir to the recommended level.	_____
If the fluid is contaminated, have the power steering system flushed and filled with the recommended power steering fluid.
