**PCC auto program at CCHS gets alignment machine**

PCC's Fremont Campus has received a Hunter G-111 wheel alignment machine that it will use to train dual-enrollment students taking its Automotive Technology college classes in the auto shop at Canon City High School. The donation was made by the Lindner Chevrolet auto dealership in Canon City, and was arranged by John Duston, our Auto Service Technology instructor. PCC began offering dual-credit auto classes at CCHS last fall, enabling students to gain ASE-certified training while earning college and high school credits simultaneously. Graduating PCC student Frank Cowgill is Duston's assistant instructor. Sterling Jenkins, Coordinator of Academic Advising at the Fremont Campus, has played a huge part in working with CCHS counselors, Duston and AST Dept. Chair Robert Maez to get students enrolled.
